### **EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

- A. **APPOINTMENT OF NEW PREFECTS FOR THE 2019/2020 ACADEMIC YEAR:** On the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2020, a new crop of prefects was appointed to man students' affairs during the 2020/2021 school year. This current appointment made **OSEREBHAMEN BECKLEY** as the first senior prefect, while **ULUEME OVIE** and **AYIKA CHRISTIAN** were named as second and third senior prefects respectively, among others.
- B. **WORLD BOOK DAY:** This year's celebration of the Annual World Book Day was held on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March, 2020. It was a huge success as lots of educative and informative programmes were featured to broaden the knowledge of those present.

### **DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:**

Development projects, whether physical or otherwise, in any educational setting can never be overemphasized. For they remain the most effective and indispensable wheel that drives education to a purposeful destination. As a matter of practical reality, both education and physical development are inseparable. Observers are, not therefore, surprised that the present Principal, who is a seasoned authority in education and its process is daily, and perfectly engaged in one development project or the other. Physical development remains the success base of this school. Such projects have functioned, facilitating teaching and learning directly or indirectly. Aside from their functionality as learning tools, they also enhance and create a conducive environment for learning.

- i. **SOLAR-POWERED AUTOMATIC ANGELUS BELL:** A solar-powered automatic Angelus Bell was installed on resumption for the Second term to regulate the activities of the School.
- ii. **LUMEN FILLING STATION:** Lumen Christi International High School, under the able leadership of the Principal, Rev. Fr. Dr. Theophilus Itaman has commenced the construction of our filling station, which will serve the School, the neighbouring communities, and passer-by.
- iii. **CONSTRUCTION OF CBT BUILDING:** The management has commenced the construction of a Computer Based Training centre in the School compound.

### **INFORMATION:**

- I. **CAREER WEEK:** As a yearly practice, the Career Week event will take place from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2020. It is organized to guide S.S. One students on the choice of subjects best suited for their careers or professions in their senior certificate classes. *Parents and guardians are expected to be in attendance on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup>*, and should encourage their children or wards to participate in this all-important programme. For its sponsorship, each student is expected to pay the sum of N7,000 only.
- II. **BAPTISM:** As a Catholic institution, we are morally obligated to give willing students the advantage to utilize the opportunity offered by the school to get groomed through moral, catechetical and scriptural orientation to get converted and baptized, while others will have their first Holy Communion.

However, Baptism and First Holy Communion for qualified candidates will take place on the 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020, 10:00am. Candidates for the Baptism and First Holy Communion are expected to pay the sum of ₦2,500 only for their certificates and administrative charges.

### **III. SUMMER TOUR/EXCURSION:**

Following the School's system as yearly done by the school management, necessary preparation has been put in place to coordinate the summer tour/excursion for students during the long holiday. The school nominates Port Novo for Basic 9 students for their summer tour this season.

- IV. **EXTENSION CLASSES:** The School Management wishes to inform all parents/guardians that the extension classes which was originally slated for the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 2020 has been postponed until further notice.

- V. **PENDING DEBIT IN POCKET MONEY ACCOUNT:** Due to the outstanding debit on student's pocket money account, the School management is urging parents/guardians to confirm and settle debit note on child/ward's pocket money account during payment of the School fees, and the receipt must be shown at the point of entry at the School gate.
- VI. **SUPPLEMENTARY & MID-STREAMERS' EXAMS:** Sales of Supplementary and Mid-streamers' entrance forms begin on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020. - VII. **ABUJA CONFERENCE:** This year's Nigerian International Secondary Schools Model United Nations (NISSMUN) Conference tagged: "Five Years of The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): Moving from Commitments to Results" attended annually by our Senior students, will take place on 17<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2020 at the International Conference Centre, Abuja. Interested candidates are to pay the sum of **₦175,000** into the School's **Pocket Money Account Number 3035243507**. The money covers the flight to Abuja, and other logistics during the conference.
